September 21 st	Paul Thwaites 6722 3090	Auburn Vale area near Inverell	Daywalk organized by the Inverell Bushwalking Club near the northern foreshores of Copeton Dam.
September 27 th	Peter Laffan 6771 3097	Majors Point to Point Lookout near Ebor	Follow the escarpment from Majors Point to Point Lookout. Some steep sections off track with some thick scrub in places. Lovely beech forest and spectacular views in fine weather.
October 5 th	Gary Roughley 0487335959	Moore Creek area near Tamworth	A day walk in the scenic Moonbi Ranges north of Tamworth. Walking along the creek and on tracks.
October 10 th to 13 th	Kathy King 6772 5401	Gibraltar Range National Park east of Glen Innes	A four day walk along the circuit track linking many of the parks attractions. All on track with optional side trips to features of interest. Lots of wildflowers.
October 19 th	Kathy King 6772 5401	Mount Duval near Armidale	A day walk to the summit. Lovely forest but limited views due to the tree cover.

November 1 st	Peter Rodger 6772 0464	Gara Gorge near Armidale	Daywalk along the southern rim of the gorge to Mushroom Rock. Spectacular views of the gorge.
November 2 nd	Joan Germany 6721 0094	Gibraltar Range National Park east of Glen Innes	Daywalk organised by the Inverell Bushwalking Club along one of the many tracks in the park to see the waratahs and other wildflowers.

January 24 th to 26 th 2015	Paul McCann 6772 6156	Washpool National Park east of Glen Innes	A three day walk down to Pi Pi Flat to see the lovely Christmas Orchids and camp amongst the tall Blue Gums and Brush Box. Expect thick vegetation, slow going and leeches if it rains.
