

Saturday 2nd to Sunday 3rd September	Paul McCann 0456368680	Guy Fawkes River National Park east of Guyra	Overnight walk descending Bees Nest Ridge to the Guy Fawkes River and following the river upstream past a feature known as London Bridge. Return up another ridge overlooking Connaughtmans Creek.
Sunday 10th September	Paul McCann 0456368680	Mount Yarrowyck west of Armidale	Joint day walk with the local branch of the National Parks Association to the summit of Mount Yarrowyck. An easier walk to the rock paintings at the base of the mountain will also be possible.
Saturday 16th to Sunday 17th September	Peter Laffan 0428821069	Gara River east of Armidale	Overnight walk down a ridge to the Gara River with shorter walks up and down the gorge.
Sunday 24th September	Joc Coventry 0448727001	Four Mile Creek near Hillgrove	Day walk down into the gorge of Four Mile Creek near Hillgrove.
Saturday 30th September to Monday 2nd October	Peter Laffan 0428821069	Warrabah National Park west of Uralla	Three day walk along the Namoi River west of Uralla with some rock hopping and frequent river crossings. Granite bluffs and rocky pools are a feature of this walk.
Monday 2nd October to Friday 6th October	Bruce Turner 6722 3267 after 7PM	Girraween National Park and Cunninghams Gap area in southern Queensland	Day walks from a base camp or cabins in Warwick along tracks either side of Cunninghams Gap and visiting Girraween National Park on route. Please advise the leader if interested by August 31st so accommodation can be arranged.
Saturday 7th to Sunday 8th October	Kate Carter 6771 2642	Salisbury Waters near Armidale	Beginners overnight walk along a steep track down to Salisbury Waters from Dangars Falls. This walk will provide an opportunity for those interested in doing overnight walks to test their ability carrying a heavier pack and to learn what to bring (and what not to bring).
Saturday 14th to Sunday 15th October	Peter Roger 6772 0464	Dangars and Mihi Gorges near Armidale	Car camp Saturday night with an optional easy day or afternoon walk on the Saturday. Sunday will be a harder walk descending into Dangars and Mihi Gorges. Rock hopping and some scrambling can be expected on the Sunday walk. Great views down the gorge from the ascent back to Dangars Falls.
Saturday 21st to Sunday 22nd October	Leontine Barnett 0428851952	Five Day Creek near Point Lookout	Overnight walk into the gorge of Five Day Creek with a steep descent and steep ascent on Sunday with a great view of the valley if weather conditions permit.
Saturday 28th to Sunday 29th October	Joc Coventry 0448727001	Long Point area east of Armidale	Overnight walk along the River near Blue Mountain Creek with a steep descent Saturday and a steep ascent on Sunday. Great views from the ridges both days.
Saturday 4th to Sunday 5th November	Donna Smith 0429642351	Nundle area near Tamworth	Day walks in the Nundle and Duncans Creek area camping on the leader's property Saturday night.
Saturday 11th to Sunday 12th November	Ken Barnett 0428851952	Canoe trip venue to be decided	A two day canoe trip along a river to be decided closer to the date depending on river levels. There may be some portages if the river levels are low.
Sunday 19th November	Kathy King 6772 0454	Long Point area east of Armidale	Day walk to several features of interest in the Long Point area with views over the surrounding gorges.
Saturday 25th to Sunday 26th November	Peter Laffan 0428821069	Georges Creek area near Point Lookout	Overnight walk along Georges Creek through lovely beech forest where some of the tallest trees in NSW can be found. Expect some thick vegetation in places.
Sunday 3rd December	Paul McCann 0456368680	Gibraltar Range east of Glen Innes	Joint day walk with the local branch of the National Parks Association to view the Christmas Bells which grow in the upland swamps. Optional off track side trip to Old Mans Hat if interested.
Sunday 10th December	Peter Laffan 0428821069	Majors Point area near Point Lookout	Day walk north of Majors Point with great views over the valleys to the east if weather conditions are favorable.
Sunday 17th December	Paul McCann 0456368680	Wollomombi Falls east of Armidale	Easy half day walk and Christmas lunch at Wollomombi Falls. There might even be water in the falls as an extra bonus for Christmas!

NOTE ALL WALKS ARE SUBJECT TO LAST MINUTE CHANGES IF RIVER LEVELS, BUSH FIRES AND WEATHER CONDITIONS MAKE FOR UNSAFE WALKING. ALWAYS CONTACT THE LEADER PRIOR TO THE WALK AT LEAST A WEEK IN ADVANCE. IF YOU ARE UNSURE ABOUT A WALK DISCUSS IT WITH THE LEADER.

LEADERS SHOULD ENSURE THEY HAVE A PRINTED COPY OF THE WAIVER FORM FOR ALL PARTICIPANTS TO SIGN AT THE START OF THE WALK. A DIGITAL COPY WILL BE EMAILED TO ALL MEMBERS ALONG WITH SOME NOTES AS TO WHICH FORMS NEED TO BE COMPLETED ESPECIALLY IF CHILDREN (UNDER 18) ARE PARTICIPATING IN THE WALK. THE LEADER NEEDS TO SIGN AND DATE THE BOTTOM OF THE WAIVER FORM. COMPLETED WAIVER FORMS SHOULD BE RETURNED TO ARMIDALE OUTDOORS AFTER THE WALK OR GIVEN TO THE TREASURER IF THEY ARE ON THE WALK.

ALSO ENSURE YOU HAVE AT LEAST ONE DISTRESS BEACON WITH THE GROUP AT ALL TIMES. THE CLUB HAS A DISTRESS BEACON FOR USE ON CLUB ACTIVITIES ALONG WITH A WATER FILTER AND SOME CLIMBING TAPE USEFULL ON WALKS TRAVERSING STEEP SLOPES. THESE ITEMS CAN BE COLLECTED FROM ARMIDALE OUTDOORS. ALTERNATIVELY ARRANGE FOR ANOTHER MEMBER WHO IS PARTICIPATING ON THE WALK TO COLLECT THE DISTRESS BEACON AND OTHER ITEMS FROM ARMIDALE OUTDOORS.
